ITA Euro Payment Policy

From EMU Countries (European Monetary Union)

When transferring money to the ITA Euro account from countries participating in the European Monetary Union (EMU) no transfer costs are charged for any of the parts of the transfer.

The EMU countries are: Belgium, Germany, Finland, France, Greece, Ireland, Italy, Luxemburg, the Netherlands, Austria, Portugal and Spain.

From Non - EMU Countries

Transfers to the ITA Euro account from countries NOT participating in the EMU means transfer costs are charged. The sender has to make sure when setting up the transfer that all transfer costs will be paid by the sender. This can usually be checked on the form. If you are unsure please ask at your bank. If insufficient funds are received the ITA cannot guarantee their services.
